Nearly five decades have passed since those happy days.

We had Morris Marina 1800cc area cars

there were no

stab vests

asps

parva


and the PRs worked only when they felt like it.....

but we had a dog from hell.



'Hades' in the ancient Greek religion and mythology, is the *god* of the dead and the king of the underworld, with which his name became synonymous.

Just about everybody who was stationed in Thanet at that time will remember Hades, weighing in at 112 lbs he was quite hard to miss.



Margate in particular was quite rough in those days, attracting large groups, happy to fight or run riot, if given the opportunity and Echo Delta 9 was always a welcome arrival when things 'kicked off'.

Originally a gift dog, he had previously been kept at the Duke of Wellington, in Ryarsh.

He had bitten a tradesman working on the premises, who's bad fortune was our good.

He was already 18 months old when the force acquired him, which was viewed as a challenge in training terms, but he took to the job like a new lion at the Colosseum.

Something that rapidly sharpened my report writing skills.
